## PHEASANT SHOOTING IN CZECH

### *Finest Wing-Shooting near the Castle Schillersdorf/CZ*



The pheasant shooting in Silherovice (Schillersdorf, CZ) looks back to a centuries-long tradition. Being set up after the English model of the Rothschild family, the pheasant shooting in Silherovice is still an insider tip for a particularly beautiful and interesting hunt.

Under the able leadership of local professional hunters the pheasants in the last decades developed very well.



Avid and passionate hunters ensure an interesting and very challenging hunting experience. Per hunting day there will be approximately six to seven drives, mostly four in the morning and three in the afternoon. The not too excessive morning

drives will mainly be not to high often with the so

called Contra-drives. In the afternoon the famous dingles and trenches will be used for hunting, providing hunters with the opportunity to test their hunting abilities.

The lunch break will either take place in the area itself - it is a hunting lodge with an open fireplace - or optionally in a former hunting lodge of the Rothschild family.

The presentation of the bagged pheasants takes place at the end of each hunting day. It is strictly following the traditions and special pattern of the Rothschild family as you can see in the picture.

## The hunting areas

The hunting area of Mährisch-Ostrau was first discovered by the family of Rothschild, founded in 1858. It is characterized by alternating tree plantings of maple, oak, beech and birch. All of those positioned in squares strictly following the English model. The landscape varies from flat-fields which are mainly used for agriculture until very hilly areas, which distinguish themselves by many wells and trenches.



The Pheasantry of Silherovice (Schillersdorf) itself consists of two districts: Vodnac and Stipcky. Vodnac is based on the original Rothschild area and has many interesting opportunities for pheasant shooting. Topographically this rather flat hunting area varies between fields and forest. The second hunting area – Stipcky - on the other hand is very hilly and is particularly suitable for pheasant hunting under the Scottish model using the natural circumstances, such as wells and trenches.



The hunting areas have a total of 4.000 hectares. Annually the number 90.000 pheasants is reintroduced to the wild. The median yearly bag is around 50.000 pheasants. Fully-grown pheasants reach an altitude of up to 40m in January.

## The accommodation

## Recommended package

You will be arriving at Airport Ostrava/CZ. The perfect itinerary normally is: Staying 3 nights with 2 full hunting days on driven pheasants in the above described very undulated and heavily wooded terrain estate "Schillersdorf" just about 20 min from the lodge

Everything you can think of is included:

- 100 birds per gun
- all brunch and lunch in the fields
- all paper work and hunting administration, gun-import, licenses + insurances are prepared
- shotgun-shells of all gauges, gun loaders, beaters, dogs, bird pickers up, etc.
- all transfers from/to airport in Ostrava, all field transportation; vehicles are coaches and shooting busses
- all tips for the staff of the chateau, the beaters, the loaders, the bus driver



## Price & Conditions

Talking about a group of 6 to 8 hunters the following prices are charged for the full program as mentioned above:

### Price per day/per hunter 3.945 EUR

Over the quota shooting 25 EUR per pheasant

Deposit/Final payment: A non refundable deposit of € 1.500 is required to confirm a reservation per hunter. The deposit amount must be received within 14 days of invoice in order to retain the slot reserved. Final payment is due 60 days prior to departure and is non-refundable unless client replacement is provided.
